Minutes

The School Council were informed that the fence has now been painted, and the 'Buddy Bench' has been built. Mr Burnett now needs to paint it.

A discussion was held with the children around 'Playground Buddies'. The children suggested the following.

Who?

- Pupils from Y3, Y4 and Y5 could be the buddies
- Two pupils could be chosen from each class
- Classes could vote for buddies
- A rota would be best so that people could take turns
- The winner of Ollie the owl could be the buddy for that week

When?

- Lunchtime and playtime
- Rules are needed e.g. Pupils are not allowed to ask to be it.

Clothing

- House colour bib
- Band (similar to Playground Leaders)
- Yellow bib/Purple bib with Playground Buddy printed on
- Could have the harp on
- Could have a slogan – Happy to help (like Tesco)

Other

- Playground Buddy of the week would get an award in assembly
- Buddies could sit on the Buddy Bench
- A job description is required
- Caedmon Characteristics could be printed on to the bench

We decided that we need to break this down in to manageable tasks, as we cannot do it all at once.
