



# **Caedmon Primary School Remote Learning Offer**

**Caedmon Primary School**  
**Remote Learning Offer – Rationale**

The staff at Caedmon Primary School have put together a remote learning offer for all children across the school. The purpose of this is to ensure that there is a robust contingency plan in place to ensure all children have access to quality education in the event of further lockdowns, bubble closures or self-isolation.

During the school closure period, between March and September, children have missed a significant amount of their learning as well as personal development opportunities. The staff at Caedmon are determined to ensure that they are doing everything they possibly can to support children to catch up on lost learning as well as meeting their social and emotional needs.

The school is part of the DfE 'Get help with technology programme' to support pupils with remote learning in the event of a bubble closure. In addition, alternative arrangements will be made for those children who do not have access to an electronic device or the Internet. In these cases, paper copies of work will be sent out to the child, contact will be made by the class teacher each fortnight via telephone call to discuss any difficulties the child is facing. Parents have been asked whether they would prefer paper packs or online learning. Paper packs are being sent to all families, however, online learning is being sent only to those families who requested it.

The programmes that school has opted to use for remote learning are:

- Seesaw for our Nursery and Reception pupils. This will be supplemented with other online links such as CBeebies story time; Ruth Miskin phonics
- Oak Academy for our Year 1 to Year 6 pupils
- Purple Mash for Nursery to Year 6 pupils

Year 1-6 teachers will demonstrate how to use the online learning resources in school to ensure children are able to easily access them at home. Updates will be given to children and sent out to parents to address any teething problems. However, as this is a new way of working for staff, parents and children, there may be a few issues initially and we ask parents to be patient and to stick with it while we all get used to this new way of working.

We will review and improve the offer as the year goes on and are happy to discuss this with parents at any time.
