



## Full School Closure – Lockdown January 2021

### Remote Learning Offer Addendum

This addendum should be read in conjunction with our Remote Learning Offer for Parents and our Remote Learning Policy which are both available on our website.

Remote learning during this lockdown will reflect the full curriculum that would be on offer if the children were present in school. **Remote learning will consist of 3 hour of lessons per day for EYFS and KS1 pupils and 4 hours of lessons per day for KS2 pupils plus additional daily reading and mental health and wellbeing activities.**

We know that many families need flexibility, therefore the work is set daily and can be accessed flexibly across the day to suit family circumstances. Families are welcome to contact us for support at any time during working hours either by email to the class teacher or by phone call to our main office.

Paper packs of work are available on request and will mirror the online learning on Seesaw. Otherwise, all work is uploaded to our learning platform 'Seesaw' – see below:

Each lesson to contain a teacher explanation sheet and a related independent activity.
<b>Marking and feedback.</b>	All independent activities should be responded to as they would be following a lesson using the feedback facilities (comment, like and send back if required) on Seesaw.			
<b>Contact with families</b>	All children to receive a phone call from their class teacher at least fortnightly – more often if required.  Families can seek support/contact teachers via email or by phoning the school office.			
<b>Mental health and Wellbeing</b>	All children to receive regular activities to support with positive mental health and wellbeing which will be uploaded to Seesaw.
