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School Trips & Visits

Year 2 visited Kirkleatham Owl Sanctuary. They learnt all about different types of owls.



Year 5 have worked with Kidzconnect this term, focusing on a number of key skills, mainly team building. They completed a variety of tasks to help improve their team work and communication across a number of weeks. Also, experts from the North Yorkshire Moors came in to help the children learn about the outdoors. They had an ecological survey of the school grounds and biodiversity, by surveying the invertebrates and measuring trees to find out how old they were. Most recently, Kidzconnect have focussed on map symbols and orienteering.



Year 3 visited the Ryedale Museum as part of their topic on Stone Age to Iron Age. The children made clay pottery, practised threading, and explored a round house where Iron Age families gathered to eat and live.



Year 5 visited Jorvik Viking Centre and DIG. Year 5 explored the Viking city and had a hands-on archaeological adventure to discover the most exciting artefacts from 2000 years of York's history!
